Hui o Ho'ohonua (HOH) is a community non-profit focused on engaging the community in the restoration of Pu'uloa (Pearl Harbor). Our hui, almost 5000 to date, consists of schools, neighbors, military volunteers, partnering non-profit organizations, businesses and conservation agencies – join us!

`Ohana (which may be schools, businesses, community organizations) are asked to coordinate with HOH staff by registering online using the QR code below. Our staff will follow up with an email to arrange a site visit with the `ohana leader or the entire `ohana. Please note that responses to the COVID pandemic may impact the size of groups we can host but rest assured, we have solid COVID-safety guidelines in place.

Those who adopt-a-plot will be asked to visit their site at least once a year to remove rubbish and invasive weeds and, help us plant native species. There are also opportunities to grow and hanai native plants at your home and to set up fun-educational activities for your visits to Kapapapuhi Point Park with the HOH staff. `Ohana groups are always welcome to visit our website – malamapuuloa.org – to learn more and access our free educational activities. Our educational activities are adaptable to multiple locations, including your backyard!
